Under Results, Efficacy Analysis, Changes in FEV₁, there was a spelling mistake. It should correctly read as follows:

On the other hand, changes in FEV₁ in liters were evaluated in all the studies [17, 26–28].

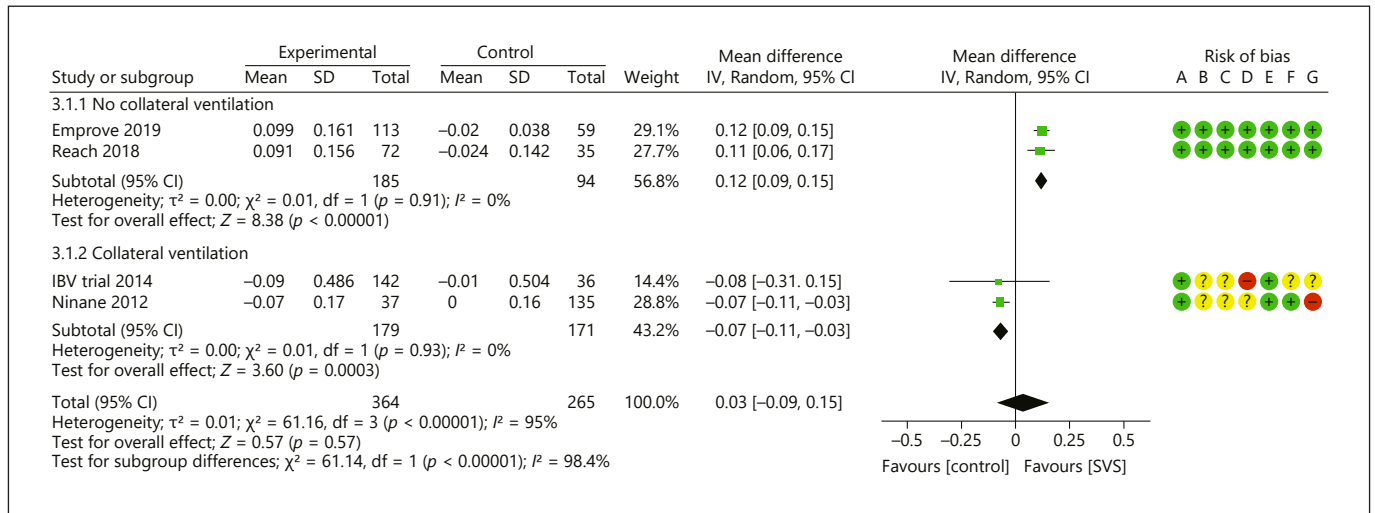


Fig. 4. Forest plot. Subgroup change in FEV₁ according to CV. SVS, Spiration Valve System.

In Figure 4, the total number of subjects for the IBV trial is $n = 142$, and the total number of subjects for the Ninane et al. [26] trial is $n = 37$. The values are inverted; however, this error did not compromise any results in the pooled meta-analysis. The correct figure is as follows:
