It will principally contain solicited reviews, on topics relevant to diagnostic anatomic pathology, written by leading authorities. Most issues will be centered about a specific theme or subject area under the direction of a guest editor. It is the purpose of the journal to free authors from the usual constraints imposed on manuscripts by providing them with sufficient space for text and illustrations, thereby allowing for a fuller exposition of their subject. Authors will be encouraged to express their personal opinions and attitudes and to challenge or support currently held concepts in their areas of interest. Basic science topics will be considered for publication if directly relevant to diagnostic pathology. Traditional case reports will not be published.

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
